

Companion Course

COURSE INFORMATION

Designed for non-pilot passengers, the Companion Course is focused on giving the right seat passenger information that will help them practice landing the aircraft in the case of an incapacitated pilot. This course covers fundamentals of flight, flight instruments, communication radio usage, transponder, and autopilot basic operation. Ultimately, it is designed for a spouse, child, or business partner to build confidence in the ability to land a private aircraft if the pilot should become incapacitated. We highly recommend that this course be conducted in a simulator of the same type aircraft that is normally flown. Also, to ensure the best experience, only the non-pilot/passenger and instructor will be in the simulator. Companion Course 1.0 is a Prerequisite for Companion Course 2.0.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1.0 includes cockpit orientation, flight instruments, fundamentals of control, radio, autopilot, avionics usage and approach to landing practice with the non-pilot/passenger in the right seat.

2.0 reviews 1.0 concepts, lands in VFR conditions, learns how to correct conditions when exceeding a defined pitch, bank, altitude, heading or other targets, and practices landing while descending through cloud layers.
